WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Take classes that count for both High School AND College credit!

As a Coastal Alabama student, you have access to all that the college has to offer:

- Advising / counseling / tutoring services
- Student activities / organizations and athletic events
- Campus amenities

50% off tuition for eligible public-school students in Baldwin County

\$81 per credit hour! Half off Alabama's lowest tuition, and no hidden fees!

No location restrictions

No credit hour limitations

3 credit hours: \$243

4 credit hours: \$324

Payment plan available

Tuition costs are current but subject to change each school year.



Courses must have a minimum number of students and may be cancelled if that number is not met.

Students participating can pay for tuition online through their OneACCS account after the 50% scholarship has been applied at the beginning of each term.

Textbooks and /or any lab fees required for dual enrollment courses must be purchased by the student.

CLASS OF 2022

Current Juniors who are already participating in dual enrollment will be able to complete their 18 hours under the previous agreement at no cost. Credit hours over 18 will be the responsibility of the student, but at the discounted rate!

ACADEMIC DUAL ENROLLMENT

Academic dual enrollment classes can be taken at any of the Coastal Alabama Community College campuses, online, or on your local high school campus after school hours

- Seated or hybrid courses at high schools will vary by location and will be outside the regular school day. Please see your counselor for available options at your school.
 - Schools will have "study hall" time during the school day for students to work on their online courses



WHAT COURSES CAN ITAKE?

Students may take most of courses in the Coastal Alabama Course Catalog

Courses numbered below 100 and Physical Education (PED) courses are not eligible for dual enrollment/dual credit.

Eligible courses depend on grade level and local school requirements for credit

Not generally grade-level specific

- Music and Art Appreciation
- Foreign Languages (French and Spanish)*
- Speech
- Psychology

Grade-level specific courses / core content areas:

- Science
- Math (testing requirement)
- English (testing requirement)
- History

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ACADEMIC COURSES

10th, 11th, or 12th grade

GPA of 2.5 or higher

Minimum ACT or Accuplacer Scores for English and Math

ACT Requirement

- 18 or higher sub score for English
- 20 or higher sub score for Math

Accuplacer Requirement

- 5 for English
- 267 for Math



CAREER TECHNICAL DUAL ENROLLMENT

Programs available based on location
Students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA*
CTE Scholarship funds available
May still be taken during the regular school day where available

Short Certificates available fully online include:

- Administrative Office / Medical Office Technology
 - 24 credit hours
- Child Development
 - 9 credit hours
- Computer Applications Specialist
 - 28 credit hours
- Drafting and Design Technology
 - 12 credit hours
- Paralegal
 - 9 credit hours



^{*}Coastal Alabama receives a waiver for a lower GPA requirement, which is subject to change.

CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY

Students will maintain continuous eligibility so long as they earn a grade of C or better in all attempted college courses.

Students who fail to meet this minimum grade requirement OR who withdraw from a course will be suspended from the program for a minimum of one term.

- The one-term suspension may not be served during the summer.
- Students who wish to withdraw must do so through the CACC Dual Enrollment website.

Withdrawing from courses or not meet minimum grades may affect future college interactions



ADA / FERPA

FERPA

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1975 (FERPA) protects the confidentiality of student educational records. Confidential information such as grades, absences, grade point average, social security number, hours earned, and class schedule will not be released to another party without the written authorization of the student.

If a student is attending a postsecondary institution - at any age - the rights under FERPA have transferred to the student.

- Parents may not contact CACC Instructors or offices to discuss private information.
- Parents still retain the rights under FERPA at the high school and may inspect and review any records sent by the postsecondary institution to the high school.

Returning Students: Submit Dual Approval Form to counselor

New Students: Enroll as a student at Coastal Alabama Community College

Online Application / CACC Dual Enrollment Website

- Please use a personal email account (Gmail, Yahoo, etc.), not your assigned school email address.
- Students will receive an email within 24-48 hours confirming their submission and assigning them an "A Number"
 - Tells students to submit documentation to admissions office-disregard and submit to high school counselor.



SUBMIT TO COUNSELOR:

Admission Documentation

- Dual Approval Form
- Transcripts that show unweighted GPA, Current ID OR Birth certificate and INow / Chalkable profile page with photo.
- Test scores (ACT or Accuplacer) are required if you wish to take Math or English

If you wish to take the Accuplacer, you can do so through our Placement Testing website after you have completed the online application http://www.coastalalabama.edu/testing/


Dual enrollment staff will process applications and conditionally admit students. Admission questions should be directed to us, not the College admissions office.



NEXT STEPS, CONTINUED

- Look for your Acceptance Letter
 - Comes to email used to create application
 - Contains your Coastal student email address
- Student Login Page
 - Set up your student email, then you have access to all student resources and platforms
 - Your Coastal email address and password is your key to being a successful student at Coastal Alabama!

Note: dual enrollment students automatically have a hold on their accounts. Students may not make changes to their schedulesmust go through their high school counselors, and dual enrollment staff will make schedule changes. Students wishing to take seated courses on a Coastal Campus will meet with dual staff to schedule.







TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Make a good impression with your personal email!
- As soon as you get your acceptance letter, set up your student email account!
 - Your email and password are your login credentials for everything-CACC is a "single sign-on" institution

Check your Coastal email regularly!

- Keeps your account active
- Your instructors will only email you through your Coastal account

Notices of course changes or cancellations will come to your student email!

- Attendance policy is not the same as your school policy-follow your instructor's syllabus
- Your classes will follow the College calendar and may not line up with your high school calendar
 - Spring break may not be the same week
 - Final exams may not line up with your school exam schedule

You must provide your unofficial transcript to your counselor at the end of each semester-can be printed from OneACCS
